Return to Nets

ECB guidance and the hard work of Rothley Park CC's committee means we can open our nets from Saturday 6th June under strict conditions.

Note: You will need to book the nets. Details below:

The RPCC management committee has welcomed the ECB announcement that, in line with the latest Government Guidelines, outdoor exercise is to include cricket net practice. The club has made sure that our facilities are ready for members who wish to exercise in the nets from Saturday 6th June and our booking system is now open for those who have registered as a member of Rothley Park Cricket Club for the 2020 season. Anyone not yet registered, will not be eligible to use the facilities.

As we all are becoming accustomed to, there are rules (summarised below) and it is essential that any member using the nets follows the latest Government Advice on personal hygiene and social distancing at all times.

Updated ECB Guidance

1. Small group cricket activity, training or fitness in groups of no more than six (6), is permitted, keeping two (2) metres apart at all times.
2. Social Distancing of at least 2 metres must be maintained at all times (unless all participants are members of the same household).
3. Cricket coaches, can now undertake small group sessions of up to six (6) people including the coach (1:5) and they must comply with ECB safeguarding policies (as well as being able to conduct one-to-one coaching).
4. No saliva or sweat should come into contact with the ball at any time.
5. Wash hands at home before and after using the outdoor facilities. Bring your own hand sanitiser where possible.

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To comply with the ECB's requirements, RPCC has:

1. A booking system for use of the nets. Please note that the new nets are not available to use and we will be using the old nets located near the clubs car park. Please note this is only the left hand net, and the right net must not be used.
2. A sanitation procedure between each use/booking.
3. A representative of the club on site during the hours that the outdoor facilities are open for use.
4. Hand Sanitation station will be provided on site.
5. The club is allowing groups of a maximum of 6 people to book a net (senior players only).
6. The club at this time will not be allowing juniors to train in groups of 6, however they can still booking to use the nets with their household.
7. Players must bring their own balls/unless it is a coaching session.
8. The clubhouse will not be open (Therefore please bring your own drinks bottles and refreshments and be aware that the toilet facilities will not be available)
9. The gates will be locked when the facilities are not open. If you have not booked to use the facility you are NOT allowed on the ground.
10. Each booking will be 1hour (More details on the next page).



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To comply with the ECB's requirements, RPCC has:

RPCC will also ensure that all members who use the facilities:

1. Are registered members and have made a booking.
2. Have checked for symptoms of COVID-19.
3. Avoid public transport if it all possible.
4. Comply with the conditions of use.



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How to book the facility:

Available times are available via this [calendar](#), and each booking will be for 1 hour (consisting of 50mins of exercise and 10 minutes crossover time).

Members must leave the ground as soon as the 50 minute net session is complete. Hire is free of charge for members, however one to one coaching is also available to be booked with our Head Coach - Anish Patel.

1. Preferred date and time (from the available slots shown on the calendar only.)
2. The names of both participants/all family members
3. An email address for the Conditions of use document to be sent to.

ALL BOOKINGS MUST BE CONFIRMED BEFORE ATTENDING THE GROUND.

A club representative will be present and able to verify the session is booked on arrival. Only members booked in will be allowed on site to use the facilities.
